1. The MN Legislature has enacted legislation pertaining to transfer and the MN Transfer Curriculum (MNTC). The law states: "Once a course has met the criteria necessary for inclusion in the MNTC in any area of emphasis, the course must be accepted for full credit in that area of emphasis at all MN State Universities and Colleges." Normandale Community College follows MNSCU's interpretation of the transfer legislation: "A completed course which is included as part of one or two goal area(s) at the sending institution must be accepted for full credit within the same one or two goal area(s) at the receiving institution."
 2. Goal 2* is met at NCC by completion of 40 credits/10 goals of the MNTC.
 3. A maximum of 16 credits for technical coursework will be accepted as electives.
