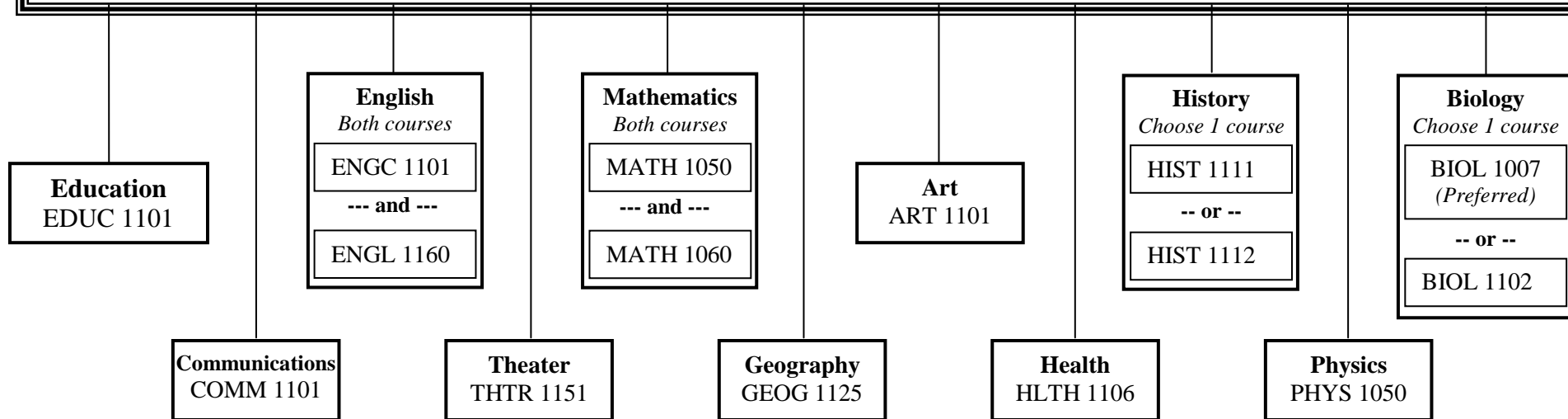

NCC information:

Students should take Introduction to Education **EDUC 1101** their **first semester** at NCC.

Students pursuing the AS in Elementary Education Foundations program must choose a middle school specialty in Math, Science or Communication Arts and Literature.

Students in the Special Education program must complete the core courses and the specific special education courses.

MSUM information:

Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 and complete the Praxis I exam before being admitted into an MSUM cohort.

MSUM uses the cohort model. Therefore, students are required to be full time.

MSUM **Elementary Education** Degree program cohorts begin **FALL** semester only.

Application Deadline: February 28.

MSUM **Special Education DCD** Degree program begins **SPRING** semester only.

Application Deadline: October 15.
